1) Complete and return the Application Form

- a. You can scan and email or send via traditional mail. Be sure to read each section carefully and provide all requested information, making sure you can fulfill your commitment.

2) Distribute the Reference Forms

- a. Please distribute a reference form to your pastor, a teacher/employer and another adult who is not related to you. Returning Staff only need a reference form from their pastor. (Additional information may be requested for those returning with any concerns from Camp Bethel or referring leadership.)

We accept applications from candidates ages 14-24, with preference given to older applicants. (Younger staff may be accepted for day shifts.)

Stipend (paid) positions start at age 16. All summer staff are encouraged to send Camp Bethel approved support letters to friends, family and church to supplement your stipend.

The deadline for application submission is April 28, 2023

Applications will be accepted after this date but may not receive full consideration.

All staff work together in various areas, but here are some examples of service opportunities during your time at Camp Bethel!

Kitchen (17 and older): This is the ministry of food preparation. You will be responsible to ensure that our guests receive well-prepared meals. You will be asked to arrive early in the morning and will report directly to the Food Services Supervisor. Aprons are provided. You will need closed-toed, non-slip shoes.

Baker (18 and older): The baker is part of the kitchen staff and reports directly to the Food Services Supervisor. You will be required to compute measurements and recipes, as well as carry heavy objects. Aprons are provided. You will need closed-toed, non-slip shoes.

Dishroom: This position ensures the sanitary cleaning of all dishes and kitchenware and reports directly to the Food Services Supervisor. Aprons are provided. You will need non-slip shoes (Black if possible)

Server: The servers graciously serve each meal to our guests and report directly to the Food Services Supervisor and the Dining Hall Host. Aprons are provided. You will need closed-toed, non-slip shoes. Please wear Khaki pants or shorts and a polo shirt.

Maintenance (18 and older): This position will include painting, weeding, construction, demolition, etc. and will report to the Maintenance Supervisor.

Lifeguard: You will be required to hold current lifeguard, CPR and first aid/AED certifications. Lifeguards are responsible for guarding at the lake and for the maintenance and cleaning of the lake area. You will report to the Director.

Gymnasium: Our indoor gym with rock climbing wall, basketball, volleyball and other activities. This position will consist of staffing during hours of operation, cleaning up before and after use of the facility, setting up meeting spaces, and helping to run games as needed. You will report to the Director.

Housekeeping: In housekeeping, you will be responsible for the daily cleaning and weekly changeover of various camp facilities. Housekeepers also assist with the camp store and snack shop. You will report to the Director or appointed volunteer/Camp Bethel staff member.

“Caboose” Snack Shop/Outpost: As part of the snack shop you will work shifts that vary according to our groups, stock vending machines, handle money, take inventory, create purchase orders, and make sure that all areas of the snack shop are properly maintained and clean. Outpost help will include cleaning and stocking, greeting and helping customers, and assisting regular Outpost staff. You will report to the Director or Outpost Manager.
